

On Saturday, 5 March, 2011, the Santa Margarita District Training Team will conduct BLST training for Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters, those who expect to hold these positions in the future, and those registered Scouters who are simply interested in improving their leadership skills.

The course will be held at the Oceanside Elks Lodge, 444 Country Club Lane, Oceanside, California. Check in and registration will begin at 8:00 am, and training will start promptly at 8:30 am. Lunch will be available at the Elks Lodge or you or can bring your own. We will finish not later than 4:00 pm.

Registered Scouters from all Districts and Councils are welcome to attend. Cost is \$5.00 a person which will cover materials and snacks. Early reservations are encouraged, but we will accept anyone who arrives by 8:15 am. 




